

Living Donor Application and Donation Process

1. Call transplant center to learn about becoming a living donor.



2. Discuss living donation option with a transplant professional.



3. Draw blood type, if transplant center agrees.



4. Provide income information for living donor candidate and transplant candidate to transplant center. (see below*)



5. Transplant center will file an on-line application on behalf of living donor and transplant candidate.

6. Make Travel arrangements with NLDAC travel agency if application approved. NLDAC will send credit card with approved limit for meals and travel expenses.



7. Travel to transplant center for an evaluation and education on living donation.



8. Travel to transplant center for living donor surgery if medically suitable and agreeable.



9. Travel to transplant center for follow up if transplant center deems necessary.

*Federal Income Tax statement for the most recent year , electronic government assistance transfer card, pay stubs, or any document confirming participation in a government assistance program including: HUD section 8 Housing subsidy, Medicaid, Food Stamps Program, or the WIC Program
