NLDAC Eligibility Screening Tool



NLDAC must assess the recipient's ability to help their donor with the cost of travel, lost wages, and dependent care before approving an application. To do this, we use income guidelines, which are set at 350% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines. If the recipient's household income exceeds our guidelines, we must assume they could reimburse their donor, unless they submit a financial hardship waiver worksheet which demonstrates expenses that bring their income within our guidelines. NLDAC gives priority to donors whose household income is also within the income guidelines. Anonymous, non-directed donors are assigned to a preference category based on their own household income, and NLDAC does not require or consider information about their recipients while reviewing these applications.
